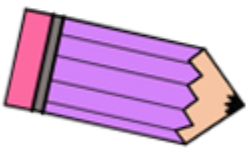


# Thin questions:

What happened after?



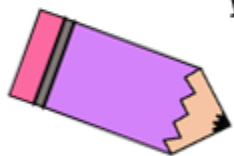
# Thick questions:

Thick questions make us stop and think!  
They cannot be answered with a yes or  
no!

# Thick question starters:

Why do you think \_\_\_\_\_ did \_\_\_\_\_?

What do you think the author meant by this  
quote " \_\_\_\_\_ "?



What would you have done if you were in  
the story?

Why do you think the author included this  
part?

Has anything like this ever happened to  
you?
